This paper represents the last part (vol. III) from a series of compendiums which covers all ultrasonography applications in the clinic. It's a unique imagistic paper in the Romanian literature, being the foundation of knowledge in medical practice for a large number of generations of medical intern students. The first volume of the Clinical ultrasonography compendium received the University of Medicine and Pharmacy "Iuliu Hatieganu" award in 2000 and the Romanian Academy award "Daniel Danielopolu" in 2002. The second volume of Clinical ultrasonography compendium also received the University of Medicine and Pharmacy "Iuliu Hatieganu" award in 2006.

The Medical Publishing House Bucharest republished various volumes depending on the market requirements, this way showing the value and the actuality of the paper.

The themes discussed in this paper, volume III of Clinical ultrasonography compendium, are centered on the musculoskeletal system pathology (approaching from both the body surface to the deep and also centered on special anatomic regions, from the joints), the pediatric pathology (with exhaustive approaching of children diseases, on age and on topographic regions, mainly insisting on images particularities as they appear in children). There is also a presentation of the ultrasound as a procedure of directing the interventional maneuvers (diagnostic and treatment), the value of the method in intraoperative conditions and a separate discussion of the newest developments of the

method. The information is structured from simple to complex, in a manner very intelligible and didactic. The actuality of information is guaranteed by the updated bibliographic references.

The personal experience of the authors offers the paper a quality which is imposed to the lecture accessible for the professionals, imposing itself in the same time as a reference paper in the domain.

The authors are personalities of Imagistics and Ultrasound from Romania. The team of collaborators is large and comes from all clinic specializations which guarantees the quality of all themes approached. The professional membership of the collaborators to various universities in the country can be observed which sustains the national aspect of the paper.

Clinical ultrasonography compendium, Volume III, has 727 pages. It contains a large number of precise and expressive images. The graphic presentation is exceptional; in fact it reaches the level of any other similar foreign papers.
